Apprenticeships and Traineeships

Apprenticeships – Combination of practical work with structured training to give a nationally recognised qualification and experience needed to get a job. Apprentices are contracted to an employer for a fixed time period, usually 4 years.

Traineeships – Can be delivered completely in the workplace. The majority of traineeships when undertaken on a full- time basis are twelve months long and can be either full or part time. The advantage is that you can actually earn a wage while you are being trained.
